at Hereford High School as part of the school's FFA Animal Science and Vet Science programs. Students provide daily care for the farm animals at the school with the help of the FFA Officer Team on the weekends...LaMancha goats and Katahdin sheep are also part of the program.

So far, students have been learning animal husbandry skills including grooming tools and techniques, haltering, and how to tie quick release knots. They've worked on halter breaking, and we hear Peggy Sue is making tremendous progress. She is settling in well in the pasture and even getting into the routine of coming up to the barn to be fed and cared for during feeding time.
